**I. Major Work Areas**

- A. Officer Brown's shift will be going to day shift in January and will focus on school zones before and after school.
- B. Sergeant Carter's shift will focus on the downtown area for alleged drug activity.
- C. Sergeant Strobbe's shift will focus on traffic on Custer Lane for driver's travelling at a high rate of speed.

**II. Accomplishments**

- A. Officers Coffman and Smith were dispatched to the 500 block of Santa Fe, for the report of a disturbance with a weapon. Dispatch advised officers that the male suspect was making threats, that if officers came into the residence that he would attempt to harm officers. Officer Coffman had dispatch talk with the male suspect on 911 in an attempt to deescalate the situation. The situation was resolved peacefully, with the male suspect being arrested for criminal damage.
- B. Officer Hatcher worked a burglary of a local business that had closed. A suspect was identified, and Officer Hatcher assisted in a search warrant being served at the suspect's house. Multiple items from the burglary were in the suspect's house.
- C. Officer Coffman conducted a traffic stop with an individual that was driving while suspended. Off. Coffman asked dispatch to have Andover PD send their K-9 unit to his location. Andover's K-9 indicated on the vehicle. During the search of the vehicle, Officer Coffman found 1.5 grams of Methamphetamine, .7 grams of marijuana, along with several items of drug paraphernalia. The male suspect was booked into the Butler County Jail for possession of methamphetamine, possession of marijuana, possession of drug paraphernalia, and driving while suspended.
- D. Officer Sisco was dispatched to suspects in a vehicle shooting Orbeez at victims on the street. Officer Sisco located the suspects' vehicle and the Orbeez gun. The victims did not wish to pursue charges.

- E. Sergeant Hagman responded to Cooper Drug for a subject passing a fraudulent prescription. When the subject returned to pick up the prescription, she was arrested. Her male accomplice lead Officer Orocio on a vehicle pursuit that was terminated due to road conditions. The pair was from out of state and had extensive history in obtaining prescription drugs by fraudulent means. The woman was charged with multiple felony and misdemeanor charges. The male that fled was identified and prosecution has been requested.
- F. Officer Coffman conducted a traffic stop at State and Main. While conducting his traffic stop, Officer Coffman requested a K-9 from Butler County Sheriff's office. During the traffic stop, Officer Coffman found that the driver was suspended. During the search incident to arrest, Officer Coffman found a small baggie containing methamphetamine on the driver. The passenger was also arrested for interference, along with possession of methamphetamines. Upon search of the vehicle, there was a total of 28 grams of methamphetamine, several controlled substances (pills), along with marijuana and paraphernalia. Both suspects were charged with possession, distribution, along with other charges.
- G. Throughout the month, Officer Orocio worked several cases that involved a woman stealing items from unlocked cars in the high school parking lot. These thefts spanned a several month time frame. The woman was identified and interviewed. Prosecution was requested on several burglary charges.
- H. Detective Sergeant Scheuber has now served a couple of months as the ADPS representative sitting on the CrimeStoppers board. Beginning this week, in partnership with the City of Augusta Municipal Court, Sergeant Scheuber will begin highlighting subjects with local arrest warrants on the CrimeStoppers Facebook page every Friday ("Fugitive Friday"). Sergeant Scheuber's hope is to reduce the number of active warrants while increasing the number of followers of the CrimeStoppers Facebook page.
- I. Sergeant Meckel coordinated and hosted a training class for area SRO's and other law enforcement officers entitled "Responding to Autistic Children".
- J. Sergeant Strobbe stopped a vehicle coming from one of the houses they have been watching after recognizing the driver and knew the driver to have suspended license which was confirmed. The driver resisted arrest. The driver also had drugs and paraphernalia. The driver was charged with possession of drugs, drug paraphernalia, obstruct and drive while suspended.

- A. Conducted monthly supervisor staff meeting.
- B. Attended both city council meetings.
- C. Attended the Wichita Area Crime Commission and become a member.

- D. We had a great fundraiser for two months on a No Shave November and a Don't Shave December. We donated \$550 to Core Community Augusta.
- E. Continued work on the Butler County EMS agreement for consideration.
- F. We are planning for a vacant position of Sergeant Carter for 15 months starting in February. We also have an open slot from the resignation of an officer. So, we are in process of interviews and testing to fill that position.
- G. Completed the monthly Kansas JAG Grant reports and closed out the year. We were told the FLOCK Camera system will be in place and working in the first week of February.
