ORDINANCE No. 2194

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF
CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE 5 OF THE CITY CODE
ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR ELMWOOD
CEMETERY

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1: Amendments. The following sections of Chapter 12, Article 5 of the
Augusta City Code shall be amended as follows:

Chapter 12, Article 5, Section 12-514 is hereby amended as follows:

“12-514 Monuments

No monuments or other structures shall be placed upon any lot until a design of the same, with specifications, has been submitted to and accepted by the sexton, and the location thereof on the lot approved by him or her. Monuments shall be restricted to no taller than four (4) feet and no longer than six (6) feet. Only one monument will be permitted on a platted lot, where full lots only are sold, or half lots, where lots are divided, placed at the head of the graves in line with the monuments on other neighboring lots.”

Chapter 12, Article 5, Section 12-515 is hereby amended as follows:

“12-515 Monuments and Markers

Stones marking individual graves on lots where there is a large monument, must be made of marble, granite, or some other permanent material approved by the sexton, and shall have the outer surface set in line with the markers on other graves. A maximum of two markers shall be permitted on any grave. The second marker must be at the foot of the grave and must be set flush with ground level with a 6-inch concrete collar.”

Chapter 12, Article 5, Section 12-521 is hereby amended as follows:

“12-521 Burial Service Time

No burials shall arrive before 8am or after 2pm on Monday through Friday. If a service does not conclude by 3pm the service shall be subject to a late service surcharge. No burials shall arrive before 8am or after 12pm on Saturdays. If a service does not conclude before 12pm, the service shall be subject to a late service surcharge. No services shall be held on Sundays or on any city observed holidays.”

SECTION 2: Repeal. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed. However, any section of an existing ordinance not in conflict herewith is not repealed and remains in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication in the official city newspaper.
