I. Major Work Areas

- A. In October 2021, Sergeant Carter received Officer Sisco as part of his shift and was assigned to mentor him prior to his leave for Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center. Sergeant Carter and Officer Smith will continue to teach and expose Officer Sisco to enhance his experience and knowledge of law enforcement prior to his departure to the Police Academy in November of 2021.
- B. There have been several issues that have been reported at the Augusta City Lake. These issues pertain to people fishing without a city fishing permit and keeping fish that are not within the creel limits. Officers will focus extra patrol on monitoring the lake and checking for fishing licenses and creel limits.
- C. Over the past two months, Officers have noticed there have been several issues with multiple residences around the area of 5th and Osage, and 6th and Santa Fe. These issues have ranged from thefts, illegal parking of vehicles, illegally tagged vehicles, and nefarious activity and drug related incidents. Officers have found three residences that seem to be the main culprits of these activities. Officers will begin surveillance, along with other resourceful tools for investigation, of these residences in an attempt to negate these issues. This will take place over the next few months while assigned to day shift. Citations and actions have been taken, and progress in the area has been noticed. Officers will continue to focus on this area to deter and resolve any criminal/codes issues.
- D. Officer Orocio completed Phase II of the FTO program and has started Phase III.
- E. Due to the number of traffic accidents occurring in the city in recent weeks, B Shift will continue to focus efforts on traffic enforcement in high traffic areas.
- F. Sergeant Scheuber's team will conduct extra patrol in and around Walmart for the next two months. Officers expect an increase in thefts with the upcoming holidays.
- G. Sergeant Scheuber's team have noticed several streetlights that are inoperable. While on patrol, officers will compile a list of those lights and that list will be forwarded to the electric department.
- H. Captain Relph will attend a meeting concerning the joining of the National Integrated Ballistic Information Network through an MOU with the Wichita Police Department.

- I. The fire department responded to a residential structure fire on Moyle. The fire started on the rear deck and extended into the house. We were able to contain the fire with minimal damage to the interior of the structure.
- J. The fire department responded to a report of a car fire in the impound lot on West Sixth. When we arrived, we discovered two passenger cars burning two boats as well. The fires were quickly extinguished limiting the damage to only the property involved upon arrival.

II. Accomplishments

- A. Officer Smith and Sergeant Carter were present along with Officer Dean and Sergeant Highbarger at the trick or treat street to pass out candy to children and monitor the safety of the public at the event. During this time, there were three juveniles who were reported to be lost and a possible heart attack that occurred at the event. Due to being present, Officers were able to respond quickly. Each juvenile was reunited with their parent and the possible heart attack was transported by Butler County EMS.
- B. Sergeant Carter, along with Major Marbut, Sergeant Highbarger, Officer Hellman, and Officer Davis, all partook in Trick or Treat Street at the station. Police cars and Fire apparatuses were pulled out and set up for kids to come and see and candy was handed out. Hundreds of children, if not more, attended the event and seemed to enjoy it!
- A. Officer Brown saw a subject that he identified from previous contacts and knew to be suspended. The subject also had illegal tags on his vehicle. Officer Brown positioned himself to make a traffic stop. The subject saw Officer Brown and attempted to lose him by driving through neighborhoods. Officer Brown was able to communicate with Sergeant Hagman and Officer Orocio, allowing them to get ahead of the subject and get him caught and arrested before he arrived home.
- B. Officer Gresham noticed a subject park illegally in the 500 block of Osage. Upon contact, Officer Gresham learned the subject had a suspended driver's license. The subject was also transporting an open container of alcohol and had two active warrants through Butler County.
- C. Officer Orocio completed RADAR and LIDAR training with Sgt. Johnston.
- D. Reserve Officer Vance will continue to work on his FTO training with the goal of getting released to patrol on his own.
- E. Officer Cole assisted the Mayes County Oklahoma Sheriff's Department with recovering a stolen motorcycle. Officer Cole recovered the motorcycle at a residence in the 200 block of E. Clark.
- F. Officer Coffman stopped a habitual violator for driving while suspended twice in two shift rotations. Officer Coffman also helped with information on working on getting his license back.
- G. Sergeant Strobe arrested a person in the 500 block of Osage for a drive while suspended. This area is the target area for proactive policing. The suspect had an illegal tag and no insurance.
- H. Officer Meckel gave combined Fire Prevention and Red Ribbon Week drug prevention presentations at all the elementary schools (4 presentations with 869 attendees) as well as Fire

Safety presentations at two day care centers (3 presentations with 78 attendees) along with four (4) station tours with fire demos to 66 attendees.

- I. Sergeant Johnston instructed Officer Orocio in the use of RADAR/LIDAR.
