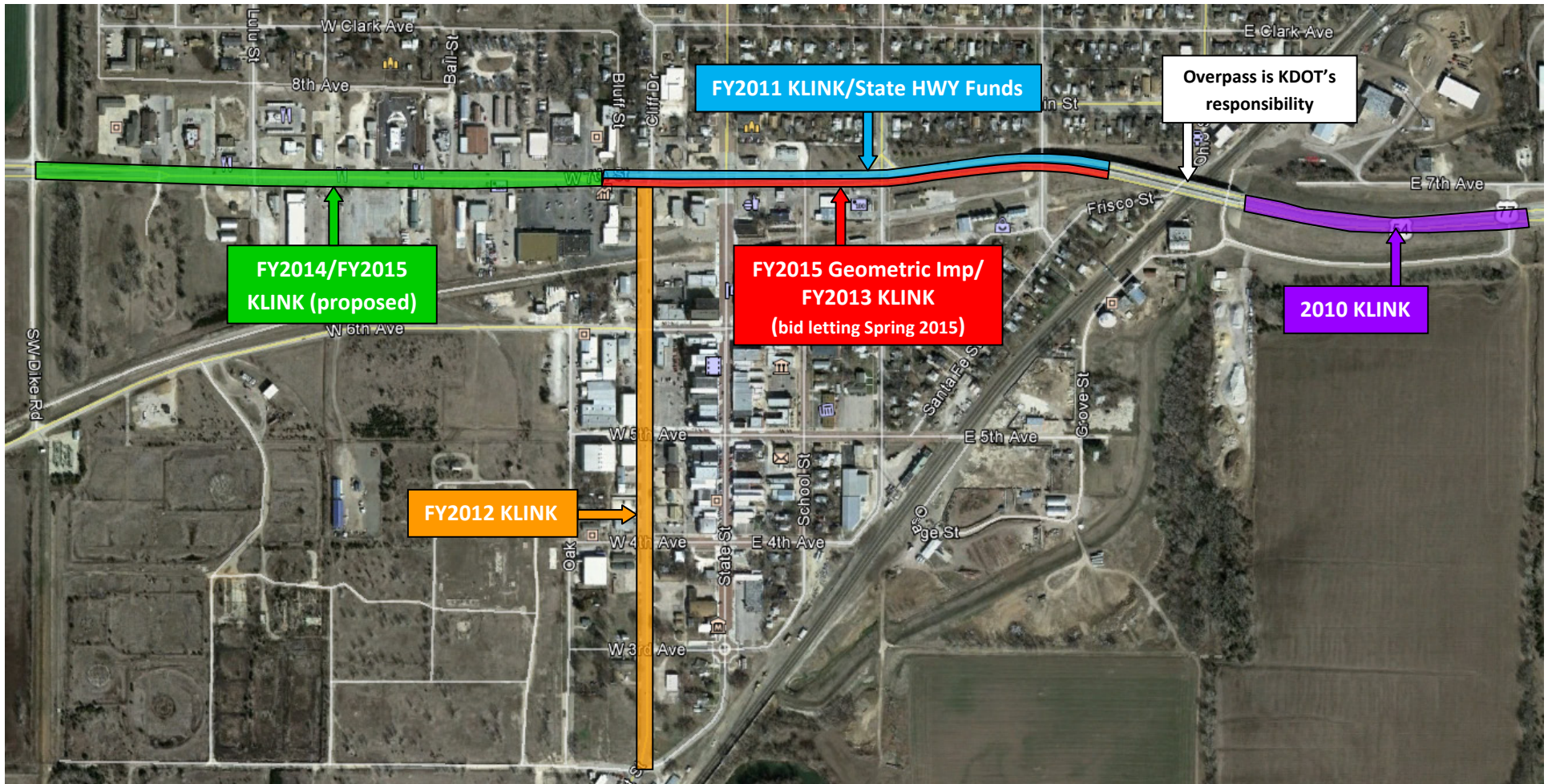


KLINK PROJECTS 2010 - 2015



ABOUT THIS MAP

The KLINK Resurfacing Program is a portion of the Kansas Department of Transportation's (KDOT) [Local Partnership Program](#) which is intended to improve the roadway surfacing of City Connecting Links of the State Highway System (portions of state highways located within city limits) that are maintained by the Cities. Over the last few years, the City of Augusta has submitted grant application requests for projects on Hwy 54/400 (7th St.) and Hwy 77 (Walnut St.) on an annual basis; occasionally multiple KLINK projects are combined to leverage additional State funding or are combined with funding sources from other State programs (i.e. Geometric Improvement program). The map above shows completed KLINK projects for 2010, 2011, and 2012 as well as planned projects scheduled to occur in future years.
