THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS

ORDINANCE NO. 2112

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE NUMBER OF
QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF AUGUSTA,
KANSAS REQUIRED TO SIGN A NOMINATION PETITION
FOR CANDIDACY FOR CITY OFFICE ELECTED AT LARGE
WITHIN THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 25-2110 provides that any person desiring to become a candidate for city office elected at large shall file with the county election officer a nomination petition or a declaration of candidacy, accompanied by any fee required by law; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 25-2110 also provides that the number of qualified electors of the city which must sign a nomination petition shall be established by the city governing body by passage of an ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS:

Section 1. Candidacy for City Office

In accordance with K.S.A. 25-205 and K.S.A. 25-2110, and amendments thereto, any person may become a candidate for city office elected at large by filing a nomination petition or a declaration of candidacy, accompanied by any fee required by law. The nomination petition must be signed by fifty (50) of the qualified electors of the City of Augusta, Kansas or by a number of such qualified electors of the City equal to not less than one percent (1%) of the ballots cast and counted at the last general city election, whichever is less.

Section 2. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication in the official city newspaper.
