THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS
ORDINANCE NO. 2116

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR
WASTE HAULING, RECREATIONAL VEHICLE DUMPING,
AND SPECIAL AGREEMENTS FOR INDUSTRIAL
CUSTOMERS BY AMENDING CHAPTER 15, ARTICLE 4,
SECTION 15-435 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF
AUGUSTA, KANSAS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 15-435 of Chapter 15, Article 4 of the code of the City of
Augusta 2010 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"15-435. WASTE HAULING, RECREATIONAL VEHICLE DUMPING, AND OTHER
SPECIAL AGREEMENTS. No commercial waste haulers or operators of recreational
vehicles shall discharge to the sewage treatment plant or sewage works of the city, any
domestic septage comprised of liquid or solid material removed from a septic tank,
cesspool, portable toilet, recreational vehicle, Type III marine sanitation device or similar
treatment works that receives only domestic sewage, or any other waste or wastewater
from a vacuum pumping truck, recreational vehicle, or other liquid waste transport
vehicle. No statement contained in this article shall be construed as preventing any
special agreement or arrangement between the city and any industrial concern whereby
an industrial waste of unusual strength or character may be accepted by the city for
treatment, subject to payment therefore, by the industrial concern. The discharge of
hailed industrial wastewater is subject to all other requirements of this article.

SECTION 2. Repeal

All other ordinances or parts of other ordinances in conflict herewith are
repealed. However, any section of an existing ordinance not in conflict herewith is not
repealed and remains in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication
in the official City newspaper.
