## WELCOME TO THE CITY OF AUGUSTA

### UTILITY BILLING INFORMATION

Your City bill will include your **Electric Usage, Electric Fuel Adjustment, Water Usage, Wastewater Plant, Garbage, Sewer and Water Protect Fee** (a State imposed fee which helps pay for water testing throughout the State of Kansas).

The Wastewater Plant fee (WWP) is based on your winter water usage average and ranges from \$15.00 a month to \$180.00 a month, per water meter. Your WWP charge will be \$25.00 for the first year of service until your average has been established. If you do not pay for your Water Usage, your WWP charge will remain at \$25.00.

The Electric Fuel Adjustment (EFA) is a monthly fee charged to all Electric customers. This fee is to help cover the cost for fuel sources (diesel and natural gas) that run the City's engines which are used to generate electricity. As the cost of fuel fluctuates from month to month, this fee will vary as well as it is based upon your total kilowatt usage for that month and the price of fuel during the month of consumption. Your utility bill will be mailed on the 1<sup>st</sup> or the 15<sup>th</sup> of every month, depending upon which area of town you live in. If your bill is mailed on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month, the due date will be the 12<sup>th</sup> of each month. If mailed on the 15<sup>th</sup>, the due date is the 27<sup>th</sup> of each month.

There are several payment options available for your convenience. You can pay your bill in person at the Utility Office, by mail or by Automatic Bank Draft Option where your bill amount is automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account. You can also pay by Debit or Credit Card by calling 1-800-272-9829 using Jurisdiction Code 6523 or via the web at [www.officialpayments.com](http://www.officialpayments.com). Official Payments, the service provider, charges a nominal fee for this service.

Any questions about your billing can be directed to the City Utility Office located at the corner of 6<sup>th</sup> and School Street. Office hours are from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. ***There is a drive up window located in the West Alley. Also located there is a night deposit box for after hour payments. If your bill should come due on a Saturday, Sunday or on a day that City Offices are closed, any payments placed in this night deposit box prior to the following workday morning will be considered as timely payments.***

## GARBAGE

Garbage pick up days are Monday and Thursday for residents south of Kelly Street. For all residence north of Kelly Street, pick up days are Tuesday and Friday. Trash should be bagged and it is preferable that no more than three bags of trash be set out per residence. If you live on a street where there is an alley, trash will be picked up in that alley. If there is no accessible alley at your residence, trash will be picked up on the curb in front of the house. Garbage Carts and/or Plastic Garbage Containers are not required and therefore will not be supplied by the City. You may purchase 33 gallon garbage bags from the City Utility Office. These garbage bags are a durable 1.5mm strength and are sold in rolls of 50 bags.

Any yard waste (grass, weeds, tree limbs, dirt, lawn and garden trimmings, rocks, sand, stumps, leaves or compost) will not be picked up by the City trucks. Yard waste can be disposed of at the City Compost site located on Grove Street. Compost hours are Saturday from 9:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. all year long and also on Wednesday, from 12:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. during the growing season. This is also the site for any recyclable garbage (see recycling insert).

City trucks also will not pick up any hazardous or unacceptable waste (anti-freeze, paint, paint solvents, poisons, radioactive materials, highly combustible materials and so on) or large bulky items such as furniture or appliances. Any large boxes can be picked up with standard garbage as long as they have been cut or smashed down to an acceptable size. If you have a large amount of corrugated cardboard to dispose of you may contact the Sanitation Department for a recycling pick up. If you have any further questions concerning your garbage pick up, contact the Sanitation Department at 775-4540.

During weeks with holidays in them, the regular routes and days for pick up may change. Notice of the changes are on the Cox Cable Channel 7 and also in the Augusta Daily Gazette.
