

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

- Approval of the 2020 Cereal Malt Beverage (CMB) License Renewal for Dillons.

**BACKGROUND:**

Under Article 2 of the 2010 Code of the City of Augusta, all persons selling any cereal malt beverages are required to have a license issued by the City of Augusta. At the time of the December 16 meeting staff was not aware that a renewal application for Dillons had been sent to and received by the City prior to the application deadline.

**ANALYSIS:**

Once staff was notified and proof was provided that the application had been sent, the only viable option that would allow Dillons to continue to sell CMB from December 31 to January 6 was to schedule a special meeting to consider the renewal application. Staff has confirmed that the proper application was submitted and the appropriate fee is being resent. The application was forwarded to the Department of Public Safety for review and approval. Dillons has met all license requirements under Article 2 of the 2010 Code of the City of Augusta.
