Want to Run for City Council?

Forms for city offices may be obtained at the <u>Butler County election office</u>. (Forms are not available online because they must be signed and filed at the Butler County election office (<u>at 205 W. Central Avenue</u>, <u>El Dorado</u>, <u>KS 67042</u>) by noon on **June 1**, **2023**.

City elections are non-partisan. In accordance with K.S.A. 25-205 and K.S.A. 25-2110, and amendments thereto, any person may become a candidate for city office by filing a nomination petition or a declaration of candidacy, accompanied by a fee of \$20. The nomination petition must be signed by fifty (50) of the qualified electors of the City of Augusta, Kansas or by a number of such qualified electors of the City equal to not less than one percent (1%) of the ballots cast and counted at the last general city election, whichever is less.
