The Council of the City of Augusta, Kansas met in regular session on January 6, 2020, with Mayor Mike Rawlings presiding. Prayer: Pastor Gene Kaufman, GracePointe Church, gave the invocation.

Minutes: Richardson made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 16, 2019 Council meeting and December 30, 2019 Special meeting. Crum seconded the motion. Motion carried without opposition.

Ordinance: Reavis made a motion to approve Ordinance 12A dated 12/24/2019. Crum seconded the motion. Motion carried without opposition.

Oath of Office:

Outgoing Ward 2 Council Member Bob Bailey was recognized for his service to the City.

Business:

Bid Award for HVAC System Replacement at WWTP Operations Building: Reavis made a motion to approve the low bid from Fahnestock for replacement of the Operations Building HVAC unit in the amount of \$11,327. Richardson seconded the motion. Motion carried with Huddleston voting in opposition.

Nuisance Abatement Resolutions for Various Properties Throughout the City of Augusta: Richardson made a motion to approve Resolution 2020-01 determining that a nuisance exists at 1318 North Helen Street and ordering the removal and abatement of nuisances within ten days as specified by K.S.A. 12-1617e. Reavis seconded the motion. Motion carried without opposition.
