I. Major Work Areas

- A. Officers have noticed increase foot traffic with the warmer weather in the middle part of the town starting in the 1300 Bobbie and the following streets east of there. Officers will increase patrol and contact people out foot.
- B. City lake enforcement. Officers will check for fishing permits, UTV permits, and after hour violations.
- C. Special enforcement on north Ohio Street, from Belmont to north city limits. Officers will look for speed, wrong way drivers, and truck route violations.
- D. Sergeant Meckel will continue planning ADPS-sponsored community events, including the annual “Bugs Bunny Club” and “Movie in the Park”, both slated for this summer.
- E. Lieutenant Johnston will work with the Butler County District Attorney’s office in establishing the final steps in a procedure to submit reports and other associated media to their office via a web portal.
- F. Sergeant Scheuber will continue to work toward establishing an online link with the Kansas Bureau of Investigation to facilitate electronic KIBRS reporting.
- G. There have been several complaints of people riding dirt bikes in Garvin Park and on other city roadways. Officers assigned to Sergeant Carter’s shift will take the initiative in June to look for these violations and issue citations for each one discovered.

II. Accomplishments

- A. Officers on Sergeant Strobbe’s shift dealt with an intoxicated male that assaulted an officer. The male was arrested after brief struggle. The call was unique being on the second floor and transporting uncooperative combative suspect. All officers handled it fine and good teamwork of transporting the suspect and working ideas to safely transport him.
- B. Sergeant Scheuber assisted the Butler County Sheriff’s Department with the execution of a search warrant at an Augusta home in which the occupants were suspected of dealing fentanyl pills.
- C. Sergeant Meckel received the six tactical vests for patrol officers from the United States Deputy Sheriff’s Association.
- D. Sergeant Meckel oversaw the implementation of the “Click It or Ticket” campaign.
- E. Lieutenant Johnston, along with other ADPS command staff members, attended a planning meeting for the upcoming citizen’s academy.

- F. Shift responded to six domestic violence disturbances resulting in five arrests and one request for prosecution.
- G. Officers on Sergeant Carter's crew responded to a call of a person not breathing and without a pulse. Officers arrived on scene first and began life saving measures, such as cardiopulmonary resuscitation. Officers and Butler County EMS were able to revive the citizen, and they were transported to the hospital. Unfortunately, after 7 days in the hospital, the citizen succumbed to their medical issues and passed away. Quick response from the officers conducting CPR gave the citizen the chance to make it to the hospital.
- H. Officer Sisco initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle for traffic infractions. The driver was found to be driving with a suspended driver's license. During the arrest, Officer Sisco found drug paraphernalia on the driver. The driver was arrested and transported to the County Jail. This was Officer Sisco's first drug arrest of his career.

III. Problem Areas

- A. None.

IV. Chief's Activities

- A. Met with Executive team and 4PC Security on a project for the city parks system.
- B. Attended a First Net Powered by ATT presentation in Wichita with DPS staff.
- C. Met with Fire Division and Makala over the new fire pay and hours. New pay rates and hours established.
- D. Attended the North Ohio Street project preconstruction meeting at city hall.
- E. Worked with Suzie and DPS staff finalizing the Citizens Academy.
- F. Attended the Kansas Assn. of Chiefs of Police training in Manhattan. During that time Sergeant Brian Smith was awarded a Gold Award for his bravery during an officer involved shooting last August. This banquet was attended by Brian's wife, Asst. City Manager Cody Simms, Councilman Lefler, Major Ray Marbut and wife, Lt. Jeremy Johnston, and Sergeant Mat Meckel.
- G. Held and attended monthly command staff meeting. Went over Special Vehicle Permits and lake patrol.
- H. Hired a dispatcher to fill one of the two vacant openings.
- I. Registering specialty vehicles. To date only 10 registrations.
