I. Major Work Areas

- A. Officer Brown's team will continue to monitor traffic in residential neighborhoods to curtail vehicle burglaries.
- B. Officers assigned to Sergeant Carter's shift will continue to focus their attention to the location of Bobbie and Harrington, where Officers conducted a search warrant in October. Officers will focus on foot activity and drug related activity in the area.
- C. Sergeant Hagman's shift will attempt to increase traffic enforcement and citations.
- D. Sergeant Strobbe's shift is continuing to focus on target areas of alleged drug activity.

II. Accomplishments

- A. Officers Brown, Coffman, and Smith responded to the report of a stolen vehicle. Off. Smith made contact with the victim, while Officer Coffman circulated the area in search of the stolen vehicle. During the investigation, it was found that the vehicle the suspect showed up in, was reported stolen out of Hutchinson. Officer Coffman eventually found the stolen vehicle at Santa Fe Terrace Apts. Both vehicles were returned to their registered owners. A female suspect was arrested and booked into the Butler County Jail.
- B. Officer Coffman conducted a traffic stop at 7th and Cliff. While conducting the traffic stop, Officer Coffman smelled the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from the driver. Off. Coffman performed SFST's with the driver. Off. Coffman arrested the driver on suspicion of driving while under the influence.
- C. Sergeant Carter's shift was dispatched to an injury accident where the driver had rolled their vehicle and was entrapped inside of it. During the attempt to free the driver, Officer Sisco discovered the driver had been operating the vehicle while under the influence of alcohol. Officer Sisco conducted Standard Field Sobriety test, which resulted in the driver being arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol. The driver was found to be intoxicated, over twice the legal limit.
- D. Sergeant Carter created and proposed the "no shave November" fundraiser. This fundraiser was for department members to grow a beard, or mustache, who paid a

donation fee to a local non-profit organization. The department is donating the funds to Core Community of Augusta, who help local students and families who are financially and educationally struggling.

- E. Sergeant Hagman and Officer Orocio responded to an out-of-control juvenile. The girl's mother had been having trouble controlling her for several weeks. The girl was taken into protective custody based on suicidal comments and the family received resources provided by the courts.
- F. Sergeant Hagman responded to a report of a stolen vehicle. Upon investigation, it was learned that the reporting party was actually using the vehicle with several other individuals to commit criminal activities in the surround area. Sergeant Hagman is working with the Butler County Sheriff's Department, the Rose Hill Police Department, and the Andover Police Department to attempt to bring charges against those subjects.
- G. Lieutenant Johnston continues to move forward in working with FLOCK Safety to facilitate the initial installation of six license plate reader cameras in or near the city limits. KDOT licensing and underground utilities locate services are next on the agenda, with a slated total completion date of February 2023.
- H. Officer Weber conducted a traffic stop and the driver was found to have a suspended license. The driver was found to have methamphetamine on him. The driver was arrested without incident.
- I. Sergeant Strobbe conducted two trash digs at an alleged drug house. Both times items of drug related paraphernalia were found.
- J. Sergeant Meckel is coordinating with AHS staff and the USD402 I.T. department regarding a number of recent vehicle break-ins in the AHS main student parking lot.
- K. Detective Sergeant Scheuber will continue to assist patrol in a drug distribution investigation with the overall goal of approaching the district court prosecutor with the case before the end of the year.
- L. Officer Cosby observed a vehicle that ran two stop signs then tried eluding her. Contact was made with driver who was found to have suspended license. The driver failed to comply with orders and had to physically restrained. A search of the vehicle was conducted where fentanyl, steroids and drug paraphernalia were found.

- F. Hosted the Sedgwick County Chief's meeting in the training room. Godfrey's Range and Tactical Supply supplied lunch for all attendees.
- G. Hosted a small group of kids for lunch from the elementary schools that won a sponsored contest. Pizza was served.
- H. We held a department luncheon for all employees for Thanksgiving.
- I. Met with staff from the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center about becoming state certified agency.
