I. Accomplishments / Highlights

- A. Officer Smith, along with Officer Cosby, responded to a past physical disturbance. During the investigation, it was found the victim had been physically abused, along with being choked by the suspect. The suspect had left the residence prior to the officer's arrival. The suspect was eventually found a short time later, where he was arrested for Aggravated Domestic Battery. The suspect was processed and then transported to the Butler County Jail on the felony charge.
- B. Officer Brown and Johnson were dispatched to the report of a disturbance. Officers arrived at the scene, where contact was made with the victim. The victim informed officers he had been attacked by the female suspect. The victim also informed officers there was a no-contact order between the victim and the suspect. Officer located the female suspect, and she was arrested for violating the no-contact order.
- C. Officers responded to a deceased individual in the 1700 block of Robbins. Upon investigation, the death was determined to be a homicide.
- D. Detective Scheuber took the lead role in investigating a homicide which occurred in the first week of September. The complex investigation is ongoing.
- E. Officer Johnson saw a Ford pickup pull out of Casey's in front of a tractor-trailer, nearly causing an accident. The pickup continued down the street with no headlamps and turned in front of another vehicle, nearly causing a second accident. The driver was stopped and subsequently arrested for driving under the influence.
- F. Officer Coffman was dispatched to a reckless driver, reported to have run a red light and possibly impaired. Officer Coffman located the vehicle and attempted to make a traffic stop. The driver attempted to elude Officer Coffman, committing multiple traffic violations. He was stopped and arrested for felony flee and elude and suspended license.
- G. Lieutenant Johnston and KLEAP Accreditation Manager Amanda Cole have been working with the rest of the KLEAP implementation group in completely rewriting the ADPS policy manual to meet KLEAP standards. As of the end of September, approximately 51% has been completed.
- H. SRO Sergeant Meckel assisted in implementing the Faith and Blue weekend by meeting with key members of the ADPS and coordinating efforts to make the event a success.
- I. Officers worked on a burglary case, involving stolen catalytic converters. Officers gathered information on the suspect. Officers applied for a search warrant, which was granted, and the warrant recovered three catalytic converters.
- J. Officers worked two sex offense cases where the victim and the suspect were individuals with special needs. The case has been completed and will be turned over to the county attorney.
- K. Officer Smith and Officer Hatcher stopped a vehicle for a traffic infraction. During the stop, the driver was found to be impaired. Officer Smith conducted standardized field sobriety testing on the driver. It was determined the driver was impaired and was arrested. While

processing the suspect, it was found he was in possession of Methamphetamine. The suspect was transported to the Butler County Jail for possession of Methamphetamine and driving under the influence.

- L. Officer Hatcher conducted surveillance in the area of 1300 block of Money. Officer Hatcher saw a vehicle leaving the area and knew the driver was suspended. After the traffic stop, the suspect's father found stolen items in the vehicle, which were turned in to officers and identified as items taken during a burglary in the city of Augusta. These items were seized. The recovery of these items was used to obtain a search warrant.
- M. Animal control worked with two rescues to rehome four animals.

II. Problem Areas

III. Chief's Activities

- Weekly meetings via Zoom with the FBI National Academy training event committee. We are hosting the FBI National Conference in Kansas City next year.
- Attended the local IMT meeting at the Butler County EOC.
- Attended via Zoom a Human Trafficking Law Enforcement Committee meeting. We will be proposing new trafficking laws this year.
- Met with Cesario and the Networks Plus representative about the IT contracts with the city.
- Held a meeting with the Sheriff and the EMS director to create protocols for response to accidents.
- The Department hosted a Glock Armorer's class. Approximately 20 people from around the state and Oklahoma attended. We supplied morning coffee and doughnuts.
- Chief attended the FBI-National Academy training in Osage Beach, MO, at Margaritaville Resort. This is a yearly training event.
- We have several safety officers in training for several weeks at night doing an EMT class for certifications.
- We hosted a TAC Medic class. Approximately 20 officers from around Kansas, Oklahoma, and Missouri attended the certification training. We supplied coffee and snacks.

By hosting these classes onsite at the DPS we save large amounts of money as we usually get free seats for doing it. Most of the time, we only need to provide coffee and snacks and sometimes lunch. As a reminder, each officer must have a minimum of 40 hours of training a year to keep certified for the State of Kansas. We also train dispatchers and admin assistants in their fields respectively.
