THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS
ORDINANCE NO. 2119

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR
DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS BY AMENDING CHAPTER
7, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 7-302 OF THE CODE OF THE
CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 7-302 of Chapter 7, Article 3 of the code of the City of
Augusta 2010 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“7-302. DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm,
corporation or partnership to discharge fireworks within the limits of the city except as
permitted by this article. The discharge of lawful fireworks will be permitted on January 1
between 12:00 midnight and 12:15 a.m. and on July 3 between the hours of 8:00 a.m.
and 12:00 midnight and on July 4 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight.
The discharge of fireworks will be allowed on private property but there shall be no
discharge of fireworks on city property unless a permit is granted by city for such
discharge. In addition, it shall be unlawful to commit any of the following acts within the
City of Augusta:

- (a) The discharge of fireworks within 1,000 feet of any hospital, sanitarium or infirmary;
 - (b) The discharge of fireworks into, under or from any motor vehicle, whether moving or standing still;
 - (c) The discharge of fireworks within 200 feet of any facility where fireworks are sold or stored;
 - (d) The discharge of fireworks within 300 feet of a service station;
 - (e) The discharge of fireworks on any public roadway, street or right of way;
 - (f) The discharge of fireworks in any manner which may pose an unreasonable risk of fire, property damage or personal injury;
 - (g) The discharge of fireworks on private property not owned or under the legal control of the person discharging the fireworks unless the person is a social invitee and has permission of the owner to discharge the fireworks;
 - (h) The discharge of fireworks toward any residence, commercial building or other structure whether intended or not.

SECTION 2. Repeal

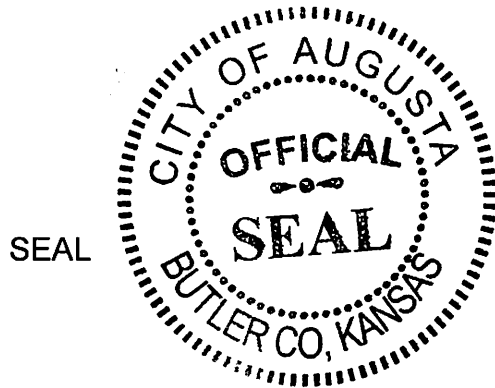

SECTION 3. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
