ORDINANCE NO. 2155

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 305 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS ESTABLISHING BOATING RESTRICTIONS FOR LAKE AUGUSTA-GARVIN PARK AND REPEALING ANY PROVISIONS OF SUCH REGULATIONS OR OTHER ORDINANCES OF SAID CITY IN CONFLICT WITH AMENDED SECTIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amending Section 12-305 of the Code.

Section 12-305 of the Code of the City of Augusta, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 12-305. BOATS; PERMITTED, RESTRICTIONS. All boats of any type or nature shall be permitted on Lake Augusta-Garvin Park except that sailboats shall not exceed 16 feet in length, and powered boats of any type with on board motors or means of propulsion greater than 10 horsepower shall be confined to residents within the city limits of Augusta subject to fees and regulations established by the governing body. All rubber rafts, houseboats or other boats with toilet facilities shall be prohibited. All boating privileges shall be confined to the citizens of the City of Augusta and Butler County, Kansas subject to fees and regulations established by the governing body. Section 2. Repeal


All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed. However, any section of an existing ordinance not in conflict herewith is not repealed and remains in full force and effect.

Section 3: Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication in the official city newspaper.


