THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS

ORDINANCE NO. 2079

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 508 OF ARTICLE 5, CHAPTER 15 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS 2010 AND REPEALING AND ALL OTHER CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND/OR PARTS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: Section 508 of Chapter 15 of the Code of the City of Augusta, 2010, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"15-508. CHARGES; COLLECTION; DISPOSAL; POLICY. The City in providing the service of collecting and disposing of all refuse and garbage accumulated within the City for the purpose of preventing unsanitary, unsightly, hazardous, unhealthful and dangerous conditions caused by the accumulation of garbage and refuse, hereby establishes the following service charges, rates and/or fees to defray the cost and maintenance of service and to pay any person contracting with the City for the collection and disposal by the contractor for the collection and disposal thereof.

(a) There shall be a charge, assessed and collected from each residential unit within the City the sum of \$14.50 per month.

(b) There shall be a charge, assessed and collected from each occupant of a residential unit within a multi-unit dwelling in the City the residential rate of \$14.50 per month, unless one of the following apply:

(1) If the property owner chooses to pay for said collection and disposal instead of allowing the occupants, who pay separate utilities, to pay the residential rate, then the property owner will be responsible for the residential rate of \$14.50 per month multiplied by the number of residential units for the property.

(2) If the property owner pays all utilities for the residential units on the property, then the property owner may elect to pay the commercial dumpster rate listed in section (f) of this Resolution based on the size of the dumpster and number of pickups necessary in lieu of the residential rate multiplied by

the number of residential units for the property as set forth in subpart (1) above.

(c) If a multi-unit dwelling has six (6) or more residential units that receive separate bills for city utilities (water, sewer, or electric), then when practical the City of Augusta may provide a commercial dumpster in lieu of residential carts for the property at no additional charge to the property owner and/or the occupant(s).

(d) There shall be charged, assessed and collected from each commercial institution, establishment, office, including but not limited to motels, restaurants, boarding houses, office buildings, stores, etc. a minimum charge of \$14.50 per month.

(e) There shall be a charge of \$7.25 per month for up to one additional standard container for both residential and commercial customers.

(f) For the collection of garbage, refuse and rubbish by the City, the following monthly fees shall be charged:

(1) The City of Augusta is hereby authorized to create a policy and program of city provided refuse and/or recycling collection containers. The policy and program details shall be established by a resolution of the Governing Body.

(2) City owned containers rented for use shall only be used for collection of refuse described herein. Other uses are strictly prohibited. The owner of private containers indemnifies and holds harmless the City for damages and maintenance of the container.

(3) An additional charge of \$2.00 per month per container will be charged if for any reason the City is required to add a lock to secure the lid(s) of said container(s) for a customer.

(g) The City will charge, assess and collect 125 percent of the above-stated charges, rates and/or fees from residential and/or commercial customers located outside of the corporate limits of the City of Augusta, Kansas."

SECTION 2. Section 508 of Chapter 15 of the Code of the City of Augusta, 2010 as it existed prior to this amendment is hereby repealed and set aside. All other ordinances and/or parts of other ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed. However, any section of an existing ordinance not in conflict herewith is not repealed and remains in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect on May 1, 2015 after its publication in the official City newspaper.
