## **ORDINANCE NO. 2099**

### **AN ORDINANCE OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS IMPOSING A SPECIAL ONE PERCENT (1.0%) CITY-WIDE SALES TAX AND RELATED MATTERS.**

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution No. 2016-05 of the governing body of the City of Augusta, Kansas (the "City"), authorized and provided for a special election in the City for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the City the question of imposing, under K.S.A. 12-187 *et seq.* (the "Act"), a one percent (1.0%) City-wide sales tax to (a) pay the costs of maintenance, repair and improvements to streets in the City, (b) pay the costs of other capital improvement projects in the City (c) reduce ad valorem property taxes in the City and (d) enhance the general fund of the City (the "Sales Tax Proposition"), with collection of such sales tax to commence on October 1, 2016, upon expiration of a current one percent (1.00%) city-wide sales tax, and to expire on September 30, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, a special election was held in the City on April 26, 2016, at which time there was submitted to the qualified electors of the City the Sales Tax Proposition, and a majority of the qualified electors of the City voting on this proposition voted in favor thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution No. 2016-05, the Act and the results of the aforementioned special election, the governing body deems it necessary and advisable to authorize the levy of a one percent (1.0%) City-wide sales tax, with (1) 50% of such tax to be applied to pay the costs of maintenance, repair and improvements to streets in the City, (2) 20% of such tax to be applied to pay the costs of other capital improvement projects in the City, (3) 20% of such tax to be applied to reduce ad valorem property taxes in the City and (4) 10% of such tax to be applied to enhance the general fund of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** The levy of a one percent (1.0%) Citywide retailers' sales tax, with (a) 50% of such tax to be applied to pay the costs of maintenance, repair and improvements to streets in the City, (b) 20% of such tax to be applied to pay the costs of other capital improvement projects in the City, (c) 20% of such tax to be applied to reduce ad valorem property taxes in the City and (d) 10% of such tax to be applied to enhance the general fund of the City, is hereby authorized, with collection of the sales tax to commence on October 1, 2016, and to expire on September 30, 2026.


**SECTION 2.** The City Clerk, upon passage of this Ordinance, shall provide a certified copy of the same to the State Director of Taxation pursuant to K.S.A. 12-189.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage by the governing body, approval and execution by the Mayor and publication once in the official City newspaper.


