ORDINANCE NO. 2107

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ELECTION OF CITY  
OFFICES TO BE NONPARTISAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH  
THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 25-2113.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 25-2113 allows the Governing Body of the City of Augusta,  
Kansas to determine whether elections for City office shall be nonpartisan or partisan; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Augusta, Kansas has determined it to  
be in the best interest of the citizens of Augusta, Kansas that elections for City office  
remain nonpartisan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE  
CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS:

Section 1. City Elections – Nonpartisan

All elections for City offices shall be nonpartisan.

Section 2. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication in the  
official city newspaper.




