Sanding and Snow Removal Street Priorities

▲ SANDING AND SNOW REMOVAL

The following is General Information for:

Streets and Parking Lots

- The snow and ice removal policy of The City of Augusta is to provide safe travel for all residents and others using our streets and parking lots.
- All primary arterial streets and school zone streets will be pretreated with brine water before storm arrives to prevent icing conditions on roadways.
- The application of sand/salt mixture will commence when the streets and parking lots become slick to cars and pedestrians.
- The street department will monitor the conditions by on-site inspection of conditions by city personnel.
- Sanding will be done from the onset of hazardous conditions to a point where snowplowing is required.
 - Criteria for this are: from a **“trace up to 3 inches of accumulations”**.
- If snow continues past the 3-inch amount, the streets and parking lots will be plowed. Salt/Sanding will follow until streets are safe.
- The snow will be removed from State Street south of 7th street when the snow has stopped.
- The street sweeper will be run as soon possible to remove sand from the roadway. The sand will be removed from the primary arterial streets first, followed by secondary streets, and then side streets and parking lots.
- To prevent snow from re-entering a driveway that has been cleared shovel snow to the right of the driveway facing the street.
